Complete Application

Complete the attached application and mail or fax to the International Student Affairs Office (contact information listed above). Or, complete the online application by visiting www.umkc.edu/isao.

Application Fee

Submit a nonrefundable application fee of \$50. Fee may be paid by check or money order drawn on a U.S. bank (made payable to UMKC). Visa and MasterCard are also accepted.

Narrative Statement

On a separate sheet of paper, write a short personal statement about your objectives for attending UMKC.

Academic Credentials

Submit copies of all post-secondary transcripts, degree certificates and graduation certificates in the native language with **literal English translations**. Applicants having less than two years of post-secondary coursework must also submit secondary transcripts and diploma in the native language with literal English translations.

English Proficiency

English proficiency is required for all applicants. UMKC accepts TOEFL scores and IELTS scores. In addition, ELS scores are accepted for some programs. Applicants who are applying for only English as a Second Language or for both an undergraduate program with English as a Second Language, do not need to show proof of English proficiency.

Applicants who have studied academic coursework for a minimum of two years (full-time) or who have earned a degree either in a country exempt from the English proficiency requirement, or from a U.S. accredited institution do not need to show proof of English proficiency. Statement of Finances

Applicants requesting an I-20/DS-2019 issued by UMKC must first submit proof of sufficient funding to meet all tuition and living expenses for the first year of studies. This funding should be in the form of liquid assets such as money in a bank account, stocks, bonds, or other investments with cash value that can be quickly accessed. Proof of financial support must be submitted in English and dated within less than 12 months prior to the date when the applicant plans to enroll at UMKC. **Copies of original financial statements will be accepted.**

Affidavit of Support

Applicants who will be supported by funds other than their own personal funds must submit an affidavit of support from the person(s) or organization supporting them. The affidavit of support can be found online at www.umkc.edu/isao/fyi.

Biographical Page of Passport

Submit a copy of the biographical page of your passport that includes your photograph and legal name. Applicants wishing to transfer to UMKC from another U.S. institution should also submit a copy of their current visa and I-20 or DS-2019.
